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**CALL TO ORDER**

Larry R. Rhodes, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

**MINUTES**

The Board reviewed an issue involving a license that was issued to an individual who had not met all of the legal requirements for licensure. The licensee was issued a license by mistake. The individual has not completed both portions of the ASBOG examination, which is a requirement for all licensees seeking licensure who are not licensed in another state. The Board has the authority to issue a temporary license to an individual that has been approved to take the examinations. Mr. Grawe informed the Board that it could issue a Temporary License to the individual in question and state that he has one year to complete both portions of the exam with a passing score in order to put his license in good standing. Mr. Grawe will draft a letter that explains that the individual has not met all requirements by law to hold registration. Mr. Wyatt made a motion to send a letter to the individual in question granting a Temporary License under 201 KAR 31:030. Dr. Cobb seconded that motion and it carried.
